The Casper Mountain and Muddy Mountain area is the focus of the Northern Laramie Range Integrated Forest Management Project. The project was a successful applicant for funding through the U.S. Forest Service State and Private Forestry FY2009 Competitive Grant Process.

Northern Laramie Range Forest Management Project is here to:

 Work with landowners (public and private) for projects concerning:

- Forest health
- Wildfire mitigation
- Forest Stewardship plans
- Community forestry programs
- Local interests in recreation, wildlife habitat, and aesthetics

 Create educational and outreach opportunities involving:


- Workshops
- Demonstrations sights
- Development of educational materials

 Expand on the ground efforts in forest management done by local agencies:

- Restore healthy tree densities
- Promote a diversity of tree species and age groups
- Continue to provide technical assistance to landowners
- Provide cost share opportunities to landowners who qualify

 Cost Share opportunities to landowners include, but are not limited to:

- Direct control of Mountain Pine Beetle infested trees
- Wildfire fuels reduction
- Forest thinning projects
